

**FOURTH GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY ORDER
AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO THE MAY 29, 2020 ORDER ISSUED PURSUANT
TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY CHAIR OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL**

Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the May 29, 2020 Order (“Order”) of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the May 22, 2020, application for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of Santa Cruz County (“Court”), this Court HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In cases in which the original, or previously extended, statutory deadline otherwise would expire from June 16, 2020 through July 31, 2020, inclusive, any judge of the Court may extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than an additional 30 days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10)).

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
