

**Superior Court of Santa Cruz County Civil Grand Jury Application Demographics  
Fiscal Year 2017/2018 - Fiscal Year 2021/2022**

California Rule of Court 10.625 directs the jury commissioner in each county to collect and maintain demographic data from prospective regular grand jurors and to make that information available to the public. The court uses a demographic survey attached to the civil grand jury application to attempt to collect this information. Some applicants decline to respond to some questions on the survey, leading to some incomplete data. The following is the data that has been collected over the previous five recruitment cycles.

Note: Prior to FY 19/20 the Court used a juror summons to compel potential jurors to appear for selection to the Civil Grand Jury although participation in the application process was strictly voluntary. The Court discontinued the use of a summons in FY 19/20 replacing it with a recruitment campaign that includes a mass mail post card, advertising with local news and social media, and showing a promotional video on Community TV and to petit jurors during jury selection for criminal and civil trials. The purpose of moving away from the summons was to provide greater access and opportunity for anyone to apply for the civil grand jury.
