

Rule 4.2.08 Inventory and Appraisal

An Inventory and Appraisal, Judicial Council form DE-160, must be filed within four months from when Letters are issued to the general Personal Representative. The Court will set a date for proof of filing the Inventory and Appraisal at the time the Order for Probate is granted. This proof date will not require an appearance in court. Compliance will be determined by the Clerk's Office. The Inventory and Appraisal must be filed five court days prior to the date set for proof of filing. If the Inventory and Appraisal is not timely filed, the Clerk's Office will set an ~~e~~Order to ~~s~~Show ~~e~~Cause hearing at which the personal representative and/or counsel will be required to ~~personally~~ appear and explain why the Inventory and Appraisal has not been timely filed.
