**FIFTH GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF
AUTHORIZED BY THE JULY 27, 2020 ORDER ISSUED BY THE CHAIR OF
JUDICIAL COUNCIL PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115**

Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the July 27, 2020 Order (“Order”) of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the July 22, 2020 request for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of Santa Cruz County (“Court”), this Court HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In cases in which the original, or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise would expire on August 1, 2020 to September 8, 2020 inclusive, any judge of the Court may extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than 30 days (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10));
