The court has reviewed the petition filed on _____ and finds as follows:

1. The petitioner has not made a prima facie showing that the respondent is, or may be, a person described in WIC section 5972. The petition is denied, and this case is dismissed without prejudice pursuant to WIC section 5977. _____

2. The petitioner has made a prima facie showing that the respondent is, or may be a person described in WIC section 5972.
 - a. Order for CARE Act Report (CARE-105) is issued this date. The Santa Cruz County Health Services Agency, Behavioral Health Division is ordered to provide notice to the respondent, appointed counsel, and the county behavioral health agency in the county where the respondent resides, if different from the county where the CARE process has commenced.

 - b. _____ is appointed to represent the respondent. Unless replaced by respondent’s own counsel, appointed counsel shall represent the respondent in any proceeding under the CARE act and shall represent the individual, as needed, in matters related to CARE agreements and CARE plans, including appeals.

 - c. The Court finds the Santa Cruz County Health Services Agency, Behavioral Health Division or their designee is the petitioner. The Court orders the matter set for Initial Appearance hearing on (date) _____ at (time) _____ in Dept 5. Notice of Initial Appearance (CARE-110) shall issue. The Santa Cruz County Health Services Agency, Behavioral Health Division is ordered to provide notice to the respondent, appointed counsel, and the county behavioral health agency in the county where the respondent resides, if different from the county where the CARE process has commenced.
