

Temporary Judges

The Superior Court of Santa Cruz County will, from time-to-time, appoint temporary judges (officially called “judges pro tempore”) to hear certain case types when the court determines there is a need to use a temporary judge. Appointments of temporary judges for this purpose will be appointed in accord with California Rules of Court (Rules 2.810 – 2.819).

Serving as a temporary judge is an excellent opportunity for an attorney to acquire judicial experience while at the same time earning Minimum Continuing Legal Education (MCLE) credits.
