

Rule 1.4.05 Public and Media Access to Remote Proceedings

Remote appearances via Zoom are restricted to parties and attorneys, and witnesses as permitted by statute, court rule, or court order. All non-confidential court hearings are open to the public for in-person access only. The media and public (“non-parties”) may not observe court proceedings remotely via Zoom. For a non-party to attend court remotely via Zoom, they or their attorney must submit a request and receive approval from the court. This request can be made through an oral or written motion or by filing the local form "Request and Order for Non-Party Remote Access SUPAD 0100." Such requests must be made at least two court days prior to the court date.
